

**IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY
UNDERGRADUATE CHEMISTRY MAJOR SCHOLARSHIPS**

Instructions for Application

THE CLIFFORD C. HACH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP. This scholarship, funded by the Clifford C. Hach Memorial Fund, and will pay up to \$6,000 a year toward tuition and fees. The four-year scholarship may be renewed annually as long as the student remains in good academic standing and remains a chemistry major.

THE ACS HACH LAND GRANT UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP. This scholarship is funded by the Hach Scientific Foundation. The purpose of the scholarship is to provide financial support for post-secondary education and to encourage undergraduate chemistry majors to pursue a high school teaching career after graduation. Scholars receive \$10,000 per academic year for up to six years. Students must meet the award criteria to renew a scholarship. The scholarship can be applied to tuition, books, room and board, and other education-related expenses.

CHEMISTRY DEPARTMENTAL SCHOLARSHIPS: Several other scholarships are available to outstanding entering freshmen.

All scholarships are awarded in two installments once each semester.

Chemistry department scholarships are available only to students who will be majoring in Chemistry.

All applicants are encouraged to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) prior to December 1st to ensure consideration for all available scholarships.

To the Applicant

1. Complete the enclosed application form. Give the completed application and these instructions to your high school principal or counselor. Your principal or counselor should mail, fax or email your application, with other attachments, to us.
2. Request that your science teacher and another teacher each write an evaluation of you as a student and person. Ask your teachers to give the evaluations to your principal or counselor for mailing.
3. Have you had any work or volunteer experience? If so, please describe briefly in your application and ask your employer to write a letter of recommendation to the selection committee in care of the address given below.

To the High School Principal or Counselor

1. Please attach a transcript of the applicant's scholastic record.
3. Please attach the scholastic and personal evaluations given to you by the applicant's teachers.
4. Mail, or scan and email the application and its attachments so that they will arrive no later than **December 1st** for guaranteed review.
